The 2025 **Roman Frontier Research Summer Workshop**, held at the Römisch-Germanische Kommission in Frankfurt am Main, Germany, was a great success.

Early career researchers from seven countries shared their work across three days of presentations, with many different provinces, methods, and academic traditions represented. Amidst the discussion was a day trip to Mainz (*Mogontiacum*), a visit inside the largest Roman theater north of the Alps, and ample time in the RGK library. 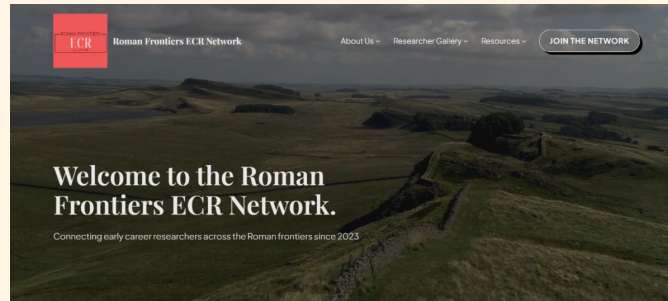
